



# Deodoro → U.S. Consulate General Transportation Guide Rio de Janeiro, Brazil

**STEP 1.** Begin your journey at either the **VILA MILITAR (preferred)**, **MAGALHÃES BASTOS, RICARDO DE ALBUQUERQUE** or **DEODORO** station (located between 1 to 2.5 miles from the Deodoro Olympic venues). Purchase a ticket for the **SuperVIA Trens Urbanos** (urban trains) from the **Bilheteria** (ticket office) outside. You can purchase a combined ticket for the train and metro for **R\$6.50** payable in cash (*Brazilian reais only*).

**STEP 2.** Pass through the turnstile to enter the departures area. Look at the overhead signs to find one of the platforms marked **CENTRAL** and board the next train that arrives. **Note:** Some cars are designated for **women only** during certain hours, so look for the pink signs to make sure you follow the rules. The ride from all Deodoro stations to Central Station takes apx. 45 minutes. **Exit the train at Central Station** (the final stop on all lines).



**STEP 3.** Follow signs in Central Station to the **METRO**. Board either a Line 1 or Line 2 train (going towards Botafogo/General Osório) to reach **CINELÂNDIA** station. Take the steps/escalator up one level to the exit and use **ACESSO F** to arrive at street level. **RUA SANTA LUZIA** will be to your immediate right next to the staircase.



**STEP 4.** Follow **RUA SANTA LUZIA** to the next intersection. The entrance to the U.S. Consulate General for American citizens is located at the corner of **RUA SANTA LUZIA and RUA MÉXICO**. Tell the guard on duty that you are a U.S. citizen and you are visiting the American Citizen Services unit. They will direct you to the ACS area after passing through security.
